Food and Beverage Sampling Guidelines

For public safety, the Southern Nevada Health District (SNHD) in Las Vegas has very strict rules and requirements to govern the safe preparation and handling of open food and beverages. ***Hot water handwashing stations and workspace sanitizing stations are required in each booth providing opened samples.*** These policies have been in place in Las Vegas since 2010.

- Factory sealed samples are exempt from these regulations.

Warning – Solicitations from Unofficial Contractors

Companies may aggressively pursue you, or your company, to solicit services (e.g., hotels) surrounding the NACS Show. Rest assured, NACS does not share or sell exhibitor contact information. Information is only provided to our [official contractors](#) to facilitate orders for services related to the NACS Show. Contact your [account manager](#) to verify the legitimacy of marketing offers.

The only NACS Official Housing Vendor is Connections Housing and reservations will open early next month. NACS has negotiated lower hotel rates for our attendees at various hotels throughout the Las Vegas area.

NACS Show Attendee Lists - Beware of Fraudulent Attendee List Sales Scam

Companies may also contact NACS attendees and exhibitors, claiming to offer our attendee lists. This is a common occurrence with large industry conferences and trade shows in recent years. NACS does not sell its meeting registration lists nor authorize any third party to distribute or sell annual meeting attendee lists or lists related to any NACS event. Contact your [account manager](#) to verify the legitimacy of any solicitation emails.

All official NACS Show attendee lists will be available via the [Exhibitor Portal](#) beginning in August 2022.

How did they get your email address? Software programs can crawl websites in search of email addresses that are listed on them (identifiable by the “@” sign).

TIP: If you receive an email offering to sell you a list of NACS conference attendees, do not respond to it. By responding, even with a request to unsubscribe, you confirm that your email address is a valid one. This may increase the likelihood that you’ll be contacted again.
