

2022 NACS SHOW SAMPLING REQUIREMENTS

Sample Sizes:

Alcoholic Beverage Sample

Beer: 5oz pour into 7oz cups (size adjustment to account for beer foam overage)

Wine: 2oz pourSpirit: 1oz pour

- Non-Alcoholic Beverage Samples – 3oz samples unlimited

Food Samples

Adherence to SNHD requirements (hot water and sanitation stations)

- 2oz food samples unlimited at no cost
- Full-size samples permitted at upgrade cost per exhibitor
 - \$200++ per day per exhibitor (total NACS Show cost for 3 days = \$600++ per exhibitor total). All fees paid by the exhibitor to Centerplate directly.
- **Demonstration**: An exhibitor who does not manufacture, distribute, or hold sole proprietorship of sampled product, but wishes to use food and/or non-alcoholic beverage to demonstrate their proprietary product is considered a demonstration.
 - Option 1: Buy food and beverage/sampling product from Centerplate, pay the cost of the food/beverage++ and offer any size of food/beverage sample since the items are coming from Centerplate.
 - Option 2: Provide own food and/or non-alcoholic beverage for sampling and Centerplate
 will apply \$200++ per day waiver fee. Larger than sample size food and beverage will be
 subject to an additional \$200++ per day.
 - Option 3: Demonstrate the food or beverage and trash/toss out or display the product –
 no fee. Displays must have signage indicating for display only and not be accessible to
 guests.
 - In the event client/exhibit is looking to offer alcoholic beverages to include beer, wine and spirits, the product would need to be purchased by Centerplate and certified.
 Centerplate bartender will be required.

All food and beverage outside of an approved demonstration/sampling must come from Centerplate as the exclusive provider of food and beverage.

Certificate of Insurance:

As referenced to the above exhibitors looking to sample and/or demo need to provide an updated Certificate of Insurance naming Centerplate as additional insured with the following requirements:

- Ensure the policy dates cover the actual show dates
- General Liability must be checked (per occurrence) and the Additional Insured box marked. If this box is not marked, there must be a description included in the description of
- Limits \$1,000,000 in General Liability coverage is required (first line). Medical Expenses must also be covered under these limits
- Workers Compensation to be marked YES
- Limits \$50,000 in Worker's Compensation coverage is required (all lines). Exceptions apply to companies that employ less than 6 employees and this coverage may be waived.
- Certificate Holder <u>MUST</u> include <u>CENTERPLATE</u> as certificate holders, naming Centerplate and LVCVA as additional insured. <u>Centerplate's Address: 3150 Paradise Road, Las Vegas, NV 89109</u>
